Required Academic Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in any discipline with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 (or 2nd class).
 - Minimum GPA of 3.00 out of 5.00 (or 2nd division) in both SSC and HSC exams.
 - No 3rd division/class at SSC/HSC/bachelor's level of education.
 - Minimum GPA of 2.00 in both O level and A level exams. For details, please visit our website.
 - Note: In order to be eligible for the test, an applicant must obtain published official result of his/her bachelor's degree on or before 18 January 2021.
- Launched in 1966, the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program is the flagship program of Institute of Business Administration (IBA), University of Dhaka. Written test for the 2020-2021 session of the MBA Program will be held on Friday, 29 January 2021 at 10:00 am. The written test is aimed at evaluating applicant's aptitude in Language, Mathematics, and Analytical Ability. An applicant must obtain a minimum qualifying score in each of these areas to pass the test.
 - After qualifying in the written test, candidates must appear before an interview board and secure satisfactory marks to be admitted to the MBA program.
 - A foreign national having a GMAT score of minimum 75 percentile may be exempted from taking the written test. However, s/he is required to appear before the interview board.
 - For all foreign certificates/degrees (excluding O and A Levels), equivalence will be determined by the Equivalence Committee of IBA. Without such equivalence, applicants are not eligible to sit for the admission test.
 - The application fee is Tk. 1200/-. The application must be submitted online by **Monday, 18 January 2021**.
